To Whom It May Concern,

As lifetime farmers, the last 30 years in the Wimmera, we have been continually attempting to create situations that improve our viability.

We were the first to grow wheat (a winter crop) under irrigation over the summer - a practice that is now used for seed propagation by all the major agricultural enterprises in Australia.

After attending an information night in St Arnaud, we were convinced that David had an ability to affect our rainfall situation. On that evening we became aware that he had no method organized to enlist our help to support his efforts. This convinced us that his talents for enhancing our rainfall were for genuine reasons and nothing else.

At the end of June 06, our local radio announcer, Dave Lennon, interviewed David about his ability to influence rainfall. The season was becoming desperate and in that interview, David Miles stated that he had instigated an event that would take 30 days to come to fruition. On the 25th of July an "unusual" rainfall event came in over the north west of the country. Our weather bureau confidently forecast that this event would only spread over NSW in the east of Australia. David told me on a phone call that he was directing it over us in the Wimmera. We had 28mm of rain on the 28th of July and Dave Lennon from the ABC has been silent since.

In spring 07, after a meeting of Aquis clients, a request for 50mm was put forward. In October and November we received 55mm and there were reports of farmers having their best season ever.

How do you reconcile, when our multi-million dollar weather bureau tells us to expect 5-10mm as on the 15th of May this year and after a request to David for at least 25mm, we receive 35mm.

Our order to David was for 25mm in June, we have had 27mm by the 23rd.

Anything that can be done to enhance and promote the ability of Aquis to continue operating should be dealt with, with enthusiasm, to benefit everyone.
